# THE ROLE OF PARENTS AND TEACHERS IN DEALING WITH PERSONAL AND SOCIAL DAMAGE OF ISFAHAN HIGH SCHOOL GIRLS

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#### Abstract

The present study investigated the role of her Board' parents and social and personal trainers to prevent injuries using descriptive research is conducted. The study sample consisted of all members of parents and teachers in schools for girls in 1596 the number of people using cluster sampling, a total of 562 persons were selected. Data collection tool was a researcher-made questionnaire. The reliability coefficient alpha 93 / 0 is obtained. For the analysis of the descriptive statistics and inferential statistics (T test Univariate and multivariate variance EGF) was used. The findings showed that all the functions (education, training and educational, extracurricular, financial and healthcare), social and personal injury prevention, which was higher than the average level was statistically significant. Independent groups t test showed that the scores of the PTA to deal with social and personal injuries by gender, membership, there is no difference in age and qualification. Friedman test also showed that the high financial and health factors in coping with the worst injuries to have personal and social.

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### **Introduction :**

Among these, the most vulnerable groups of young people in social studies are prone to injury. According to statistics, one in five young people are the majority of the world's population, 85 percent of this age group living in developing countries. And honoring the physical, psychological, social and youth is an investment for the future of the country because they have a better chance to become healthy young adults , healthy, responsible and productive (a report by the World Health Organization , 2003, quoted breath of fire Tabatabai , 1390). 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Jang et al (2013) study the role of parents in reducing anti-social behavior among 253 students of secondary schools in the nation, and these results were achieved : 1) a significant relationship between parental monitoring and oppose drinking there is a tendency to consume alcohol, ie the behavior of their children in school when parents can monitor, they will lower the alcohol. 2) Their results also showed that adolescents perceived harmful effects on the prevalence of alcohol use among their peers may be reduced through the active participation of parents. In fact, I believe that teenagers whose parents closely monitor their behavior and drinking themselves to express their opposition, they are less likely high-risk by the behavior of their peers are affected

### **Research questions :**

### Method Data :

Analysis of the data from this study using statistical software spss-170 in both descriptive and inferential statistics were performed. The descriptive statistical features such as frequency, percentage, mean, standard deviation and inferential statistics for the univariate t -test, Friedman test and multiple way analysis of variance was used.
