CONCEPT OF THE SPECIAL EDUCATION

Special education is given a name to special needs education, the education of children who vary socially, mentally, or physically from the normal to such an importance that they expect improvements of formal school methods. Special education assists children with impulsive, behavioural, or cognitive injuries or with intellectual, hearing, vision, speech, or learning disabilities; blessed children with advanced educational skills; and children with orthopaedic or neurological impairments. Hence children with specific types of impairment—cerebral palsy or deafness or blindness, for example—must be carefully analyzed before they can be appropriately spotted in a special group.

Children who achieve extremely outstanding (IQ scores higher than 130 imply giftedness) or low (scores below 70 indicate intellectual disability) is assumed for outstanding programs. CAUSES OF INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY

The result of a developed or genetic disease (such as Down syndrome (see Halle, 1994, p.40-41), a disease before or after birth or trauma before or after birth. In individual cases, It is often not possible to determine the cause of intellectual disability. Some well-known causes are genetic conditions of abnormalities in the genes of the parents, mistakes, if genes of genes during or before the pregnancy of the disease, radiation or poisoning damage or damage, Examples include Down syndrome and fragile X syndrome. CAUSES OF PHYSICAL DISABILITY

PHYSICALLY DISABILITY

D) Provide applicable device and technology and after clearing one activity other activity starting.

E) Given them (physical impairment) accessible playing material so that they can play with each other and made their social interaction.

F) Teacher have to create an environment for every child as independent as possible.

VISUALLY IMPAIRMENT

3. Mass media is the fourth pillar of society. They need to telecast more about the special child. Everyone knows that every person is our social assets. But they are always busy telecasting other news except for news about the special child.

4. Many of the special school up to class six. After completing school the special students filling the problem to complete secondary education. Many students stop their education due to higher education facility in their own distinct. So the government needto establish at least one higher secondary school.

5. The delinquency of many training teachers is the main problem to develop the special child. The special educator wand empathy but they don't get this. So the teacher needs to take care of this topic.

6. There is 25 special education college in West Bengal. Many of the teacher educators don't want to take this course. We don't forget the phrase "Teaching is not a profession" So the teacher educator need to change this type of mentality. The teacher is the pillars of our society.

7. There are only 3 Madhyamic schools (Hooghly, South 24 Parganas& Kolkata) in West Bengal. Two schools are for the visually impaired and one for the hearing impaired. There are three H.S schools (one is PurbaMedinipur, one South 24 Parganas, and one Kolkata) in West Bengal. All school for the visually impaired. Government should need to increase the number of schools. So that all category challengers complete their education peacefully. 8.There are only 16 District Disabled Rehabilitation Centre (DDRC) in West Bengal. Government should need to increase DDRC in West Bengal.
